### **NHJTFA Waiver and Release**

It is the intent of the participant's parents or legal guardians to release NHJTFA, its members and each of its directors, sponsors, volunteers and coaches collectively from any claims or liability to the fullest extent possible under the law. To advance that intent, the parents/guardians hereby agree as follows:

1. We understand and hereby acknowledge that the game of football is a full-body contact sport that presents the inherent risk of serious bodily injury, and our waiver and renunciation of claims in this agreement expressly apply to any bodily injury, damage, or accident that may be suffered by the participant or others resulting from the participant's participation in the game of football in connection with the program.
2. We hereby waive and renounce any claims against the NHJTFA or any other person participating in the program, including without limitation any claims based on negligence, for any injury to the participant or others, loss, damage, sickness, accident, delay, or expenses of any kind whatsoever resulting from the participant's participation in the program.
3. We also agree to hold harmless the NHJTFA from any and all claims arising out of the equipment or uniform supplied to participant for use during the season.
4. We understand and acknowledge that the NHJTFA does not guarantee the security or safety of program sites, of the areas adjacent to and surrounding program sites, or of any areas participants may traverse on their way to or from program sites. We release the NHJTFA from any and all claims arising out of accidents or events caused by a participant or third parties not associated with the program, which incidents could occur on program sites, in areas adjacent to or surrounding program sites, or in areas traversed by participants traveling to our program sites. We further release the NHJTFA liability for any damage or injury that may occur as a result of the surface or condition of the program site (e.g. the football playing field), or the condition of facilities or equipment used at the site.
5. We recognize that the participant must obey the instructions of coaches, their assistants, and any other program staff, and we have instructed the participant to obey said coaches and other program staff.
6. We authorize the NHJTFA to obtain emergency medical treatment for my participant as needed. In the event of emergency, we realize that 911 will be called immediately, and then parent/guardian contact will be attempted. Injured participants requiring medical treatment will only be transported by medical professionals (EMTs) or by the parent/guardian.
7. We further understand that should any medical services be provided or made available to the participant in connection with his participation with the program, the NHJTFA cannot be deemed responsible or held liable for any claims arising out of the provision of such medical services or the failure to provide or to continue to provide such medical services.
